

haphazard (adj.): بی نظم، اتفاقی، تصادفی

hyperbole (n.): اغراق، لاف رادبیات

dexterity (n.): مهارت، چالاکي، چیره دستی

These were tests of their ability to withstand pain and to practice athletic dexterity.
