

**breach (n., v.):** نقض (عهد، قرارداد، توافق و...)، رخنه، نقض کردن، رخنه کردن، شکاف ایجاد کردن

**pertinent (adj.):** مربوط، بجا

**partake (v.):** (غذا/نوشیدنی) صرف کردن؛ شرکت کردن، سهم شدن؛ دارا بودن

Refusing to partake of offered food or drink is considered a grave insult.

They both partake of an autumnal quality, a sense of approaching darkness.
